2019 Government in Action Youth Tour Application

Deadline for submitting this application is Friday,
December 28, 2018 at 5:00 pm in the Karnes City Office.

Details and Itinerary:

The Government in Action Youth Tour 2019 will begin in Austin, Texas on Wednesday, June 12th and will end in Austin, Texas on Friday, June 21st. Karnes Electric Cooperative, Inc. will sponsor one student from its service area for a 10 day all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. The winning applicant will receive a travel package valued at \$3,010.00, and will join other Texas High School students for a tour of the White House, the U.S. House and Senate Chambers, the Supreme Court, the Washington National Cathedral, Arlington National Cemetery, the Smithsonian Institution, and many other national sites. Upon returning to Austin, the itinerary will continue with a tour of the Texas State Capitol and a visit to the Bob Bullock Texas State History Museum. The travel package includes air transportation to and from Washington D.C., hotel stay, meals, entrance fees, and \$250.00 cash for miscellaneous expenses. Chaperones for the tour will be provided by the Texas Electric Cooperative Association and will accompany the students throughout the tour.

Eligibility and Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a High School student who will have completed their sophomore year of education by June 2019.
2. Applicant must reside in the home of a parent or legal guardian who is an active member of Karnes Electric Cooperative, Inc.
3. Applicant must have parental consent to apply.
4. Applicant must return the completed application and essay along with a recent wallet size photograph to the Karnes Electric Cooperative office located at 1007 North Highway 123 in Karnes City, Texas by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 28, 2018.
5. The Winner will be selected based on this completed application which includes an original essay on the subject of "What does being a member of an electric cooperative mean to your generation?" (See Essay Requirements on page 4.)
6. The Winner must be able to participate in the Youth Tour trip to Washington, D.C. They must be able to fly in an airplane and ride in a car or bus for up to 12 hours a day (with breaks).
7. The Winner will be responsible for transportation to and from Austin, Texas. They will also be responsible for additional spending money for snacks, film, souvenirs, etc.
8. The Winner will be recognized at the Karnes Electric Cooperative's Annual Meeting to be held on Monday, June 3, 2019.
9. A First Runner-up will be named to take the place of the Winner should they be unable to attend the Youth Tour.
